Legislative Update August 2024

General Comments.

MOAA National HQ provides considerable information to all members besides legislative updates, particularly if you are a Life or Prime Member. A significant aspect of these services is through frequent Webinars presented by professionals in their respective areas of expertise. Most noteworthy, is a recent Webinar regarding protecting your family from cyber crimes. Cyber criminals are very active and keep updating their capabilities. For example, beneficiaries of TRICARE-for-Life have been attacked through fake texts.

<u>Federal.</u> NDAA 2025 is STILL crunching numbers. Therefore, the list of legislative priorities will continue as in the past few months. There are significant differences between the House and Senate versions.

The Major Richard Star Act - Concurrent Receipt for Combat Injured Veterans: Two-thirds of Congress has supported this bill for the past two years, however, the House version does not include this bill in the NDAA. Back door information is that it "costs too much". Passage as an amendment to the NDAA by the Senate would more rapidly reverse the unjust offset requiring these combat-injured retirees to give up a dollar of DoD-earned retirement pay for every dollar of VA-provided disability benefits they receive.

Please request our Senators, who are already cosponsors to support a floor vote for a NDAA amendment.

Military Housing and Barracks: Both the House and Senate NDAA include provisions to invest in deteriorating barracks. Hopefully, this will stop the "lip service" given is the recent past.

Military Pay. Increase of 4.5% in basic pay has been included in both House and Senate versions. However, while the House approved a 15% raise for lower grade enlisted, the Senate version does not - again "too expensive".

Arlington National Cemetery (ANC): The Expanding America's National Cemetery Act of 2023, H.R. 1413, is not included in either version of the NDAA. The proposed eligibility reduction for ANC remains on hold in the federal rule-making process.

<u>State.</u> AB 46 Retired Pay Exemption. This bill is still alive, albeit on life support. Last month you

were given the opportunity to send a letter through the CSVSC to Gov. Gavin Newsom. If were not able to send the letter through them and would still like to, please call me - I'd be happy to help.




Pub Crawl"

- If you have a County pass, please use it and share rides to save money.


